The U.S. House of Representatives, seeking to loosen restrictions on embryonic stem-cell research, passed legislation early this month that would allow federally funded scientific research on human embryos.

Passed by a 247-176 margin, the legislation (S.5) would force American taxpayers to support the *deliberate destruction* of human life at its earliest stage. The bill now heads to President Bush, who has called the legislation a 'grave mistake' and has stated his intention to veto the bill.

A Presidential veto won't deaden the bill entirely, however. Instead, a veto will send the legislation back to Congress, where both houses can override the veto with a two-thirds majority vote.

We must hold our legislators accountable and let them know that we expect them to uphold the sanctity of human life at all stages. The Senate is expected to vote on the override first, and a two-thirds majority appears to be probable. Please call Senator Grassley and Senator Harkin and make your voice heard!
